

2018 Facts and Figures

The 23rd Annual NorthShore Inline Marathon began at 8:45am on Saturday, September 15, 2018. At the race start in Two Harbors, temperatures were about 65 degrees with a 15 MPH wind from the northeast. The race course was a little damp but dried out over the course of the day. Wind increased steadily and conditions were cloudy throughout the entire event.

- 1,894 registered participants in six races
- 1,650 finishers in six races

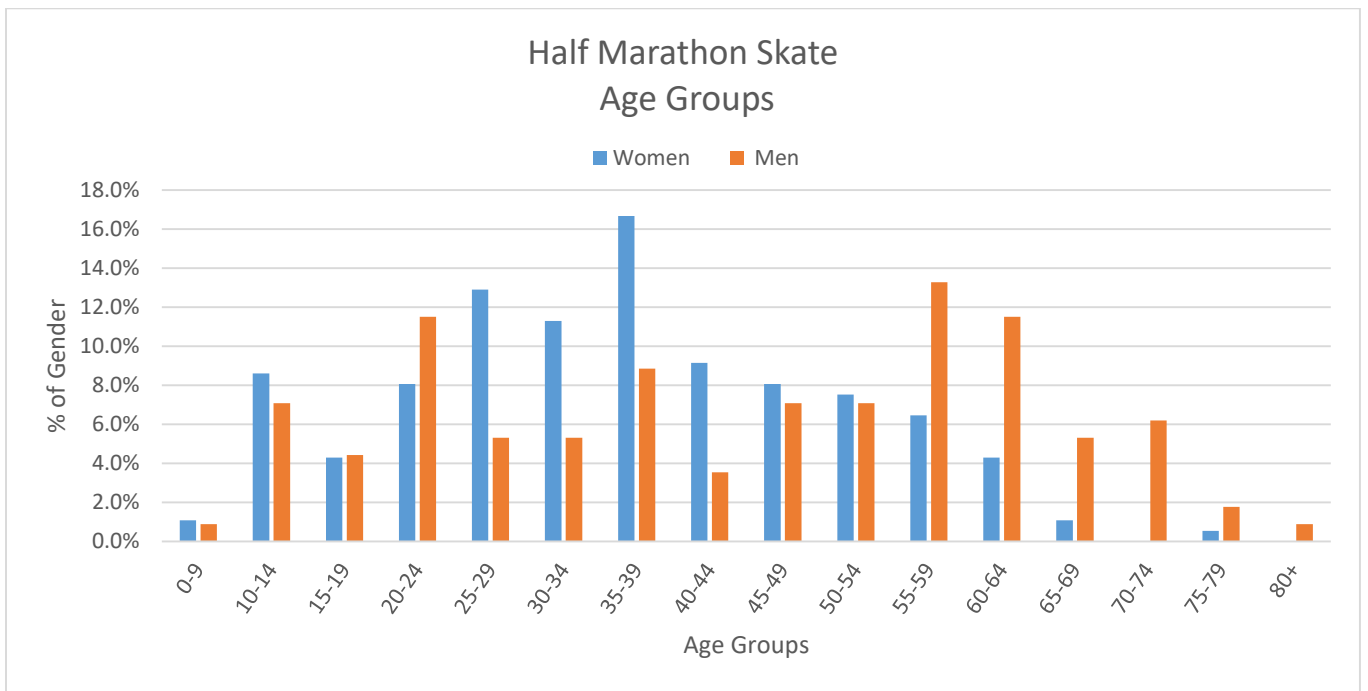
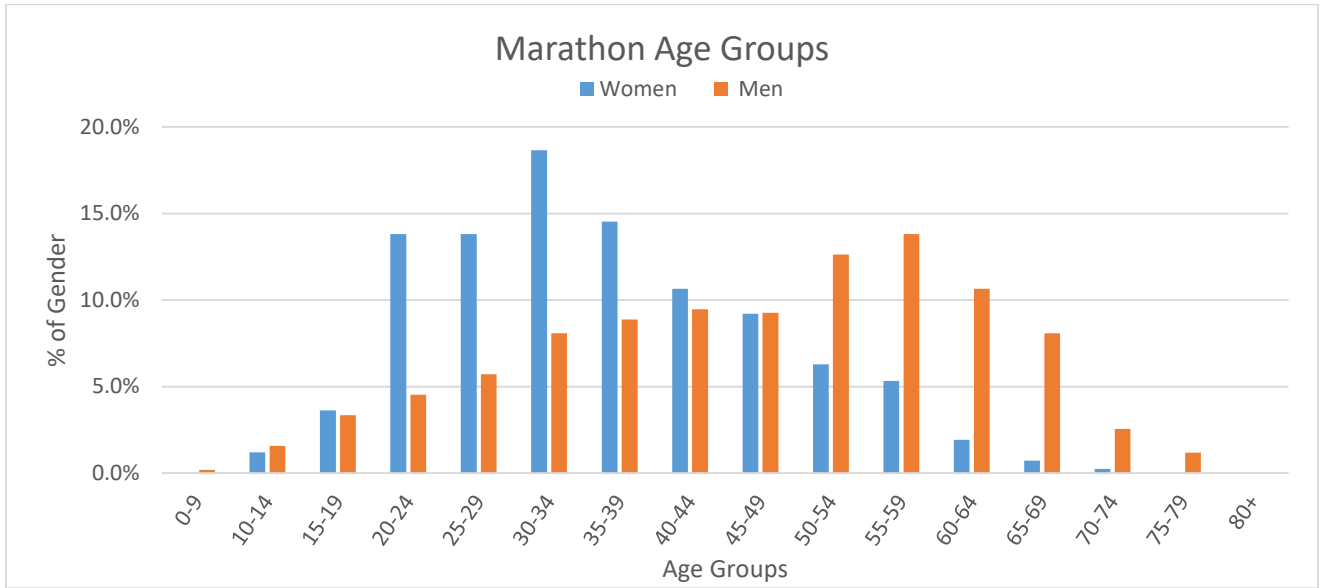
- 920 registered, 789 finishers in marathon (85.8% finisher rate)
 - 507 (55%) Male, 413 (45%) Female; Average age 42
- 92 registered, 82 finishers in elite marathon (89.1% finisher rate)
 - 75 (82%) Male, 17 (18%) Female; Average age 40
- 299 registered, 264 finishers in inline half marathon (88.3% finisher rate)
 - 113 (38%) Male, 186 (62%) Female; Average age 39
- 52 registered, 45 finishers in rollerski marathon (86.5% finisher rate)
 - 41 (79%) Male, 11 (21%) Female; Average age 42
- 28 registered, 21 finishers in combined (89.5% finisher rate)
 - 22 (79%) Male, 6 (21%) Female; Average age 42
- 147 registered, 128 finishers in wheels off half marathon (87.1% finisher rate)
 - 52 (35%) Male, 95 (65%) Female; Average age 36
- 356 registered, 321 finishers in tunnel 10k (90.2% finisher rate)
 - 94 (26%) Male, 262 (74%) Female; Average age 40

- Youngest Participant: 4 years old in the Tunnel 10k Run
- Oldest Participant: 85 years old in the Tunnel 10k Run

Participants registered from 42 US States, 3 Canadian Provinces, Venezuela, and Argentina

- All skate races:
 - 880 from MN – 63.8%
 - 143 from WI – 10.4%
 - 53 from IL – 3.8%
- All run races: 420 (83.5%) from MN, 54 (10.7%) from WI
